# WHEN SHOULD I APPLY TO COLLEGE?

Apply ASAP, but below are the most common application types.

- **Early Action:** Select whenever possible. Deadlines begin November 1st and benefits include:
  - Merit scholarship eligible
  - Reduces stress
  - Reassess options
  - Apply elsewhere if not accepted
- **Early Decision:** BEWARE this is a binding agreement reserved for your “Dream School.” Speak with parent or counselor before selecting this option.
- **Rolling Admission:** First come, first served basis. Still has deadline to be eligible for merit scholarships.
- **Regular admission:** Select this if you did not complete application by the Early Action deadline.

# HOW DO I APPLY TO COLLEGE?

- 1. Complete an online application** on the university's website one of two ways.
  - Directly to institution
  - Common App
- 2. Request transcript in NAVIANCE: Don't do this until you have submitted your application.**
  - **Directly to Institution:** Colleges – Colleges I'm Applying to - +Request Transcript - Initial
  - **Common App Schools** – You **MUST** match your Common App and Naviance accounts and complete the FERPA in Common App. Once this is done, your counselor will appear in your Common App account and will be able to submit all required documents on your behalf.
- 3. Application Fee Waiver Request**
  - **Directly to Institution:** Fee waivers will automatically be sent when you request a transcript in Naviance.
  - **Common App Schools** – You **MUST** request a fee waiver in your Common App account.
- 4. Send test scores**
  - **Many schools may still be "Test Optional." Speak with parent or counselor before making a decision.**
  - SAT and AP – Collegeboard.org
  - ACT – Act.org
  - Email your counselor to request a fee waiver.
- 5. Complete the FAFSA**
  - Opens December.
  - Parents and students must have own FSA IDs.
  - Add up to 20 schools
  - You'll receive "Award Letters" from each college to which you've been admitted showing sticker price, grants, scholarships, loans, and your out-of-pocket cost to attend

## Big FAFSA® changes are here

Different doesn't mean bad: we've got your back so you don't miss a beat.

Completing and submitting the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA®) just got easier, but you will want to know about changes too so you're prepared!

### What do you need?

If you're a dependent student, you'll need this information for you and your parents.

- ✓ You and your parents will need an FSA (Federal Student Aid) ID to access the FAFSA® and sign the form electronically. The FSA ID must be obtained at [studentaid.gov](https://studentaid.gov) before you start the FAFSA®, and we recommend applying 3-5 days before you plan on starting the FAFSA®.
- ✓ Your Social Security number
- ✓ Your parents' Social Security numbers
- ✓ **What do you no longer need?** Student and parent tax documents. All of this information will be automatically accessed from the IRS through the FUTURE Act Direct Data Exchange (FADDX).



Keep in mind that filing the FAFSA® is free—you should never be asked to pay to complete the form.



If your financial aid status has changed, you must complete the FAFSA® with the information required, and then follow up with your school's financial aid office for further advice.



To be eligible for federal financial aid, you must file the FAFSA® for each year you'll be in school.
