The Zhou B Art Center. A beautiful space in Chicago with multiple stories containing various stories of the amazing artists that have come from many walks of life in order to share their passion for art, and their stories. This is the story dedicated to the artist; Naomi Brennick. Naomi, currently attending classes and programs at the Aart Iinstitute of Chicagochicago, she's been pursuing a career in sculpting during her time at the school. In 2019, Naomi would begin experimenting with bronze casting and would sculpt the figure that could touch the heart and mind of many people. The piece of art I personally went to see was a man sculpted under the name "Daddy long legs". Daddy long legs is an all blacked out figure with elongated legs, and his most prominent attribute: His seemingly malicious mask. While the mask at a glance can be seen as a simple white mask, tThe more you look the more you see it. A seemingly devilish grin and a furrowed brown to invoke a feeling of malignancy. A terrifying figure that any who have experienced nightmares, hallucinations and dreams can

relate to. This is the

feeling Naomi Bren-

nick set out to achieve. A figure made in her mind from her own experiences, that many can relate. As said by Naomi herself when asked about what feeling or ideas she wants her art to convey: "I use not just sculpting, but material techniques to create expectations that

change the more an object is observed. My work is often based on very specific and complex stories of my life that I'm trying to translate into objects

and images that communicate how those experiences felt internally....I try to make the audience uncomfortable and intimately confronted with something that needs to be decoded and filtered through their own personal experiences." (Brennick). Naomi Brennick conveys this perfectly. Her art isn't just thought provoking, it's as if you're looking out of a window during a stormy night. You could swear you saw something... but it's only the more you look do you truly get superstitious. Your fears manifest from the darkness of what you believe to know. It's

only when you truly understand what you look at, do you realize how wrong it is to take something so seemingly menial at face value. Naomi Brennick is a genius at the Art of the thought provoking ability to make one un-



comfortable. To make one reflect on the life they've lived and the experiences they've had in order to understand her art. That leads us into the Artist herself. What is her stance on her passion? How does it feel to be an artist? What is her inspiration? And ultimately, what is her goal? I've reached out and have an answer to all of these questions. And we could not have hoped for better. To begin with, What is the main inspiration behind her beautiful art? Naomi relays: "Moments from my life are definitely the main thing that fuels my art. Stories, feelings, memories, places that I want

to spend more time analyzing and understanding on deeper levels. Often turning dark situations into something beautiful. My work touches on mental illness, trauma and pain that is more therapeutic to express than to sit with." (Brennick). To think: Taking a concept of pain and struggle, to reforge it into such a divine concept that could touch the hearts of many who take the time to analyze it. For the intermediate: What is her main goal of being an artist? "My work is often motivated by the chance to feel understood and for others to see themselves and understand their own experiences. To me success is not about fame or fortune, it's a priceless satisfaction and gratitude for what my art is recognizable as mine based on a consistent style from me and that style being unique and interesting enough to create a memory. Recognizability is a defining mile marker of "Making it" in the art world." (Brennick).

Finally, to end with something resounding. How does it feel to be an artist? "Liberation and catharsis. Being an artist feels alot like skydiving. You know you won't die but it is a risk most people would never dream of taking. Wanting to be an artist is the terrifying moment when you first

look down to realize there are no clear paths or safety nets. Being an artist is the second you leave the plane and realize the air beneath you was not a void but instead a complete limitlessness beneath your feet that had been stuck on the ground." (Brennick). She described it as an experience to those who take a risk for a chance to be free and to transcend the reality everyone is stuck in. Those with no interest won't try, but a great gift is given to those who take the jump. In her own words: "Living as an artist is sitting in the clouds imagining what the world could be instead of sitting on the ground imagining what the clouds could resemble." -Naomi Brennick. Words spoken by one of Chicago's most interesting Sculptors and Artists. I highly urge anyone curious about art to visit the Zhou B Art center. Even to visit Naomi. Some art may not be for everyone, but everyone should be for art. And if you take the time to understand her art, I hope you see Naomi's true genius.
