## SCHOOL DISTRICT 215 ENROLLMENT REQUIREMENTS

## You must have ALL the requirements below in order before enrollment can take place. RESIDENCY — All enrollments WILL be verified through Rancilio & Associates. A person who knowingly or willfully presents to the School District any false information regarding the residency of a student for the purpose of enabling that student to attend any school in that district without the payment of a nonresidency tuition charge is guilty of a CLASS C MISDEMEANOR (105 ILCS 5/10-20.12b(f). A driver's license or State ID showing a District 215 address must be provided by all

## > **Student's Birth Certificate**. (If father is NOT on birth certificate, he CANNOT enroll).

Proof of custody will be required if other than parent enrolling the student.

- ✤ Foster Student Must have a 906 form.
- **Divorced Parents** must have divorce decree indicating who has physical custody.

## RECORDS FROM THE FORMER SCHOOL

- Official transcript. (Unofficial accepted for scheduling purposes if official is unavailable)
   ISBE transfer form if transferring from IL public school
   IF TRANSFERRING from a <u>non-Illinois public school district</u> the parent/guardian must certify in writing that the student is not serving a suspension or expulsion imposed by the non-Illinois public school from which the student is transferring. In order to be admitted, the form must indicate the student is not currently suspended or expelled
- Physical & Immunizations
- ✓ Grades in progress (if entering after the 15<sup>th</sup> day of a semester)
- ✓ *I.E.P. or 504 Plan* (if applicable)
- ✓ **Diploma and last report card** IF you are a FRESHMAN enrolling directly from 8<sup>th</sup> grade.
